Dear Customer

SUB : COMPLIANCE WITH IMO REGULATIONS /SOLAR CHAPTER VI, Regulation 2, (as amended) related to VGM (VERIFIED GROSS MASS) FOR SHIPMENTS IN CONTAINERS.

REF : Enclosed copy of **M.S. Notice No.04 of 2016, dtd.11.05.2016**, issued by Director General of Shipping,

Ministry of Shipping

Dear All

With reference to above, please note the following:

- As per latest IMO REGULATIONS, Compliance with VGM VERIFIED GROSS MASS Requirement is mandatory, w.e.f. 01.07.2016, without exception.
- 2. The enclosed copy of Min Of Shipping, Director General of Shipping M.S. Notice No.04 of 2016 is self explanatory, with respect the compliance requirements, as applicable for shipments to/from India.
- 3. Gross Mass means "The combined mass of a container's tare mass and masses of all packages and cargo items including pallets, dunnage, and other packing material and securing material packed into the container".
- 4. **Verified Gross Mass means** "The total gross mass of a packed container as obtained by weighing the packed container using calibrated and certified equipment.(under Method 1)"
- 5. The basic outline of the VGM requirements are as under:
- VGM requirements are applicable for all types of containers, including Dry Containers, Reefers, ISO Tanks, FLAT RACKS, OPEN TOPS Etc.
- ii) The shipper is required to provide a completely filled **VGM Declaration** (Template as enclosed Annexure 1 of the M.S.Notice No.04/2016), duly signed/stamped by the shipper, or a person duly authorized by the shipper, with name/designation of the person, making the declaration clearly and legibly mentioned in the declaration.
- iii) The shipper is required to support the VGM declaration, with a tamper proof weighment slip, obtained from an approved weigh bridge. The details to be mentioned on the weighment slip, are to be as specified in the enclosed attachments.
- iv) The shipper is responsible for ensuring that the weighbridge used for weighment is suitably calibrated and certified by appropriate local government agencies and holds a valid certificate/licence.
- v) All costs associated with obtaining VGM data including weighment, VGM declaration in a timely manner shall be for the account of the shipper.
- vi) Shipper for the purpose of this advisory/circular shall mean " **The shipper on PAN ASIA LINE's Bill of Lading**". VGM declaration and documents are acceptable only from the shipper.
- vii) VGM declaration from Freight forwarder or clearing agent, is unacceptable under all circumstances, unless the forwarder is the "Shipper on the PAL Bs/l".
- viii) These documents are required to be submitted by the **shipper**, **prior to cut-off period for submission of such data**, to PAL, as the carrier. PAL in-turn shall submit the same data, to vessel operator/slot provider. The cut-off period for VGM Document submission, will be stipulated by PAL as the carrier to the shipper/shipper's agent from time to time.
- ix) Any containers off-loaded at terminal (Port or ICD) without VGM documents as per 3 i), 3 i) above, **should not be and will not be loaded on board/or Railed out**.
- x) All costs and consequences (direct and in-direct), arising from failure to comply with VGM requirements, are for the account of the shipper, without exception, including but not limited to, shut-out, roll-over and all other expenses.

- xi) Containers shall not be loaded over the permissible payload under any circumstances, whatsoever.
- xii) Containers overloaded in excess of permissible payload, and/or without valid VGM declaration, documentation, will not be loaded on board the vessel, under any circumstances. All costs and consequences, including but not limited to de-stuffing, lightening of the cargo, re-stow, sealing, customs approvals, shifting etc, are for shipper's account without exception.
- xiii) For Shipments originating from ICD's The containers must not be permitted to be railed out, without proper VGM Documentation in possession of the ICD AGENT/OFFICE.
- xiv) The shippers are hereby requested to educate and inform their vendors, such as clearing agents, hauliers, freight forwarders etc,
- xv) Failure to comply with VGM requirement is not an option and hence unacceptable.

6. Vessel/Feeder Operator Policy:

- a. Feeder Operator will not load any containers without a VGM Certificate, on/after 1st JULY 2016 (as same will be in violation of SOLAS/IMO regulations)
- b. Any and all associated charges due to VGM related issues (Including but not limited to, weighing, re-weighing, recertification, re-packing, shifting within the terminal and/or cancellation, shut-out, roll-over, shifting between terminals, and or port to CFS, v.v) shall be for box operator's account.
- 7. Minor Changes and modifications for one or more the procedures/processes described above, may take place prior to the **effective date(1**st **JULY 2016)** and in that case, PAL shall keep you well informed.
